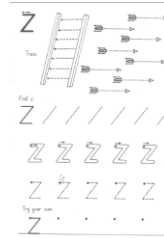

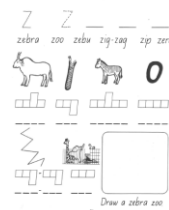

⇒ Create your own Zebra mask, we have supplied crepe paper, a popstick, a mask template and pink paper for the nose and ears.


⇒ (or you can use elastic for your mask if you have some at home)
