 - I show others Jesus' love when I put wrongs right.



English: Focus on Writing Sentences

- ⇒ Read then trace the sentence
- ⇒ Cut and sequence the sentence in the correct order
- ⇒Write the sentence and colour the illustration (remember your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops).



- ⇒ Choose 5 words from your Foundation High Frequency Words list and start your sight word workout.














Wednesday 8/9

- Check that you have started the sentence with a capital letter, you have finger spaces between each word and your sentence ends with a full stop.


Thursday 9/9

Monday 6/9


- ⇒ Sing along to the 10 Frames song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RLiwP_hxdQc

- ⇒Fill in the additional dots in the second ten from to make the number

Sheet 2

- ⇒ Using your dice, counters and your laminated tens frames chart, make numbers.
- \Rightarrow Roll the 2 dice add all of the dots together e.g., 6 + 3 = 9
- ⇒ Use counters to show the number on the 10 frames.
- ⇒ Leave the counters on the 10 frames e.g., 9
- \Rightarrow Roll the 2 dice again now add all of the dots together e.g., 4 + 2 = 6
- \Rightarrow Use the counters to add this number to the 10 frames e.g., 9 + 6 = 15
- ⇒ What is your new number? e.g.,15

Repeat this activity to practice addition on the 10 frames

- ⇒Games Day

- ⇒Continue rolling, adding and colouring until you have filled the pyramid
